

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN

WICHITA STATE UNIVERSITY AND CLOUD ASSOCIATES COMMUNITY COLLEGE

May 28, 2015

Revised February 17, 2017

The purpose of this articulation agreement is to provide a transfer pathway for students regarding the Cloud County Community College degree program in Criminal Justice for those students pursuing a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice at the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences at Wichita State University. This transfer agreement will be listed in the WSU Undergraduate Catalog for all transfer students.

Students should refer to transfer sheets for the required courses at each institution. Transfer students must complete at least 60 hours of four-year college work and 45 hours of upper division work at Wichita State University.

The following criminal justice courses must be completed by Cloud students pursuing a BSU criminal justice degree in Criminal Justice. This includes criminal justice courses at WSU.

Summary:

- 24 Hours of Criminal Justice courses to be taken at Cloud
- 18 credit hours of criminal justice courses to be taken at WSU
 - 18 core criminal justice credit hours
 Total criminal justice credit hours 42
 - May take up to 8 additional elective hours in WSU that do not exceed 30 total credit hours
- 6 credit hours of correlating courses to be taken at WSU (must be taken at Cloud to be "Correlate Core Course Requirements")
- Students must also satisfy the university's general education requirements (including the language requirement) and the university's requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree.
